ROLE SUMMARY

UnityPoint Health is seeking a Chief Medical Officer for their Cardiovascular Service Line. Reporting to the System Chief Medical Officer, the Chief Medical Officer for the Cardiovascular Service Line will work in a dyad relationship with the Vice President — Operations of the Cardiovascular Service Line and will be the accountable clinical executive for all cardiovascular services provided across the UnityPoint Health System and across all sites of service. Key activities include short term and long-term strategic planning, leading physicians and other providers in optimizing clinical, operational, and financial effectiveness and efficiency, and system leadership responsibilities. The physician leader is expected to maintain a part-time clinical practice (maximum 0.25 FTE).

Essential Functions and Responsibilities

Clinical and Service Quality Performance

- Establish strong working relationships with service line physicians (employed as well as independent partners) and other providers and stakeholders through regular and ad hoc meetings, site visits, and other connections as requested or needed
- Lead service line physicians and other health care providers in identifying unnecessary clinical and associated operational variation and developing high reliability care standards
- Champion the adoption of high reliability care standards in concert with regional and subspecialty physician and provider leaders
- Develop and review performance dashboards and monitor clinical outcomes, including but not limited to quality and patient experience results; develop and implement action plans as needed to optimize outcomes

Strategy and Business Development

- Ensure alignment of service line physicians to achieve strategic priorities and goals. In partnership with the service line dyad, ensure ongoing dialogue between physicians and key stakeholders in the execution of the strategic plan
- Partner with the Executive Director of Service Line Strategy and dyad partner to develop a short term (1-2 year) and long-term (2-5 year) service line strategic plan that is aligned with and informed by the UPH strategic plan
- ▼ Present the strategic plan to critical leadership bodies for review and alignment



- Surface ideas and provide internal consulting for new programs, initiatives, and technology investments, and participate in business plan development and discussions with all stakeholders
- ▼ In partnership with the service line dyad, establish, strategize, coordinate, and collaborate in the achievement in the key performance metrics, goals and objectives
- Participate in workforce planning discussions for physicians and other providers
- Lead the development of service line physician and provider recruitment strategies and actively participate in the recruitment process

CARDIOVASCULAR CARE AT UNITYPOINT HEALTH

The experienced heart and vascular teams at UnityPoint Health provide patients with options, personalized treatment plans, and care that's close to home for conditions ranging from simple to complex. UnityPoint Cardiovascular physicians have board certifications in most cardiac sub-specialties and can help patients coordinate additional tests, surgeries, advanced clinical procedures, and rehabilitation.

The Cardiovascular Service Line at UnityPoint Health comprises over 40 employed physicians and over 40 employed APPs. The Service Line also includes about 30 physicians and 30 APPs from independent practice groups.

Cardiovascular Care in Des Moines

Cardiovascular services are provided in Des Moines at two hospitals and 10 clinics by 15 employed cardiologists and over a dozen APPs. UnityPoint Health's flagship facility, <u>lowa Methodist Medical Center</u>, hosts a wide range of cardiovascular lab facilities including electrophysiology, catheterization, structural heart, and vascular. Operating rooms at lowa Methodist are equipped for open heart surgery and vascular surgery.



<u>Iowa Lutheran Hospital</u>, also in Des Moines, has electrophysiology and catheterization labs. There are also six UnityPoint Health Cardiology clinics and four cardiac rehabilitation clinics in town.

Cardiovascular Care in Waterloo

<u>Allen Hospital</u> and its team of cardiologists and surgeons form the only comprehensive heart care center in the Cedar Valley. Allen Hospital treats nearly all heart issues with a team of experienced cardiac specialists in Waterloo as well as outreach locations in Charles City, Cresco, Grundy Center, Independence,



Sumner, Waverly and West Union. The physicians and staff are committed to the highest level of heart care for patients in Northeast Iowa while offering a wide range of services including:

- Cardiovascular and thoracic surgery (open heart)
- Cardiovascular imaging
- Electrophysiology
- Advanced heart failure treatment and care
- Enhanced External Counterpulsation (EECP)
- Treadmill stress test
- ▼ Holter monitor and event recorder
- ▼ Heart disease prevention
- Peripheral and vascular therapies
- ▼ Sleep apnea clinic
- Cardiac and pulmonary rehabilitation

<u>The Allen Heart & Vascular Center</u> opened in 2009 to centralize all heart care in one facility and is specifically designed for heart patients and their families. Along with the physicians at the Cedar Valley Cardiovascular Center, Allen Hospital is often recognized as one of the top heart care programs in the nation.

Cardiovascular Care in Fort Dodge

<u>UnityPoint Health – Trinity Heart Center</u> opened in October 2024 and builds upon UnityPoint's tradition of great heart care in the Fort Dodge area. The team works together to ensure heart patients have the comprehensive care they need close to home. Patients have access to leading therapies and experienced, fellowship-trained cardiac specialists right in Fort Dodge. The hospital has interventional cardiology, a catheterization lab, a cardiac and pulmonary rehabilitation program, and tele-cardiology. UnityPoint locations in Des Moines and Waterloo provide open-heart coverage for Fort Dodge, a major system initiative that serves to retain open-heart procedures in-system.

Cardiovascular Care in Sioux City

Outpatient cardiovascular services and screenings are provided at <u>UnityPoint St. Luke's</u> hospital and <u>UnityPoint Sunnybrook Medical Plaza</u> in Sioux City, IA. St. Luke's cares for heart patients in dedicated electrophysiology (EP) and cardiac catheterization labs. Just steps away from St. Luke's Emergency Department, the location of the labs is one of the reasons door-to-balloon times are faster than the national average. This means less time is needed between patients' arrival in the ED to when they are moved to the cardiac catheterization lab to receive heart care. In the end, this means less heart muscle will be lost, and patient outcomes will be better.

Cardiovascular Care in Cedar Rapids

St. Luke's in Cedar Rapids, IA is home to the nationally recognized <u>Nassif Heart & Vascular Center</u>, the largest and most comprehensive cardiovascular center in the area. The center offers a full range of heart and vascular services, including preventive treatment, diagnostics, open heart surgery and the most advanced heart procedures available.

St. Luke's specially trained structural and interventional cardiologists treat patients suffering from blocked arteries, valve diseases, and structural abnormalities of the heart, all without the need for open-heart surgery. That means patients recover faster and can stay close to home for nearly all of their heart-related issues.



The team of advanced heart experts encompasses the specialists and services of <u>St. Luke's Hospital</u>, cardiologists at <u>St. Luke's Heart Care Clinic</u>, cardiothoracic surgeons at <u>St. Luke's Heart & Lung Surgery</u>, vascular surgeons from <u>Physicians' Clinic of Iowa</u>, and interventional radiologists from <u>Radiology Consultants of Iowa</u>. St. Luke's also has a unique, collaborative partnership with <u>Linn County Anesthesiologists</u>, <u>P.C.</u>, offering patients exclusive access to the only anesthesiology group in the area. This network allows UnityPoint St. Luke's to provide the highest quality of care and the best possible patient experience.

Cardiovascular Care in the Quad Cities

At <u>Trinity Heart Center</u>, part of <u>UnityPoint Trinity Rock Island Hospital</u>, patients have access to comprehensive care and personalized attention. Convenient services in Bettendorf, Moline, Muscatine, and Rock Island offer close-to-home options that patients might expect to find only in a major metropolitan area, sparing patients the stress and hassle of traveling great distances. Services provided at Trinity Heart Center in the Quad Cities region include cardiac catheterization, open-heart surgery, and cardiac rehabilitation.

Since 1999, UnityPoint Health – Trinity has helped patients access advanced heart disease treatments where they are most comfortable, close to home. The open-heart surgery program has earned national recognition for consistently delivering safe, effective care. Cardiac surgeons at Trinity Heart Center belong to <u>Cardiac Surgery Associates (CSA)</u>, a group committed to cardiovascular surgery excellence. One surgeon is a full-time staff member at the heart center, enabling more people to benefit from seamless care. Openheart surgeries performed at the Trinity Heart Center include coronary artery bypass graft, valve repair, and valve replacement.

Trinity Heart Center's team has been providing the Quad Cities area with much-needed state-of-the-art cardiovascular care since 1999. Trinity Rock Island and Bettendorf are two of only 259 hospitals nationwide to receive the 2024 American College of Cardiology's NCDR Chest Pain-MI Registry Platinum Performance Achievement Award and the only hospitals in the Quad Cities to be recognized with this achievement.



In 2023, Trinity Heart Center celebrated the 250th person to receive a successful <u>WATCHMAN</u> device from the center. WATCHMAN reduces the risk of blood clots, stroke, and reliance on blood thinners for patients with an irregular heartbeat. Trinity was the first healthcare provider in the region to offer WATCHMAN beginning in 2020.

Cardiovascular Care in Dubuque

UnityPoint Finley Hospital's <u>Heart and Vascular Center</u> contains a state-of-the-art cardiac diagnostic unit to diagnose numerous heart conditions. Patients may visit Finley's diagnostic unit for a stress test (or exercise EKG), electrocardiogram, ECHO, cardiac CT scan, or cardiac nuclear medicine test.

Patients who have a pacemaker are able to complete convenient routine follow up care with Finley's Pacemaker Clinic, also located in the cardiac diagnostic area. Pacemaker Clinic is staffed with a nurse specialist who has extensive training on the use of multiple types of devices.

<u>Finley Hospital's</u> heart experts provide services ranging from prevention and diagnostics to treatment and rehabilitation for heart and vascular health concerns. Led by the cardiologists at <u>UnityPoint Clinic</u> <u>Cardiology – Dubuque</u>, all heart care services are conveniently located and coordinated at Finley Hospital.
